Beth Schaller shared that they have their planning workshop on the 20th of November. This meeting will prioritize the transportation needs of all SW District planning partners. MoDOT has a lot of construction projects wrapping up for the season. James River Freeway project is almost completed. They are wrapping up some of the bridge projects in Taney County. The new Long Creek Bridge will be completed next month, and demolition of the original bridge will happen in Spring 2025.

David Knaut mentioned that OTO will discuss STIP priorities on November 21. OTO's number one priority is the designation of Highway 65 and James River Freeway as interstate.

7. Legislative Reports
