Old Business

1. SHSP Procurement Updates

Dorothy Wittorff-Sandgren

- Summary sheet was sent to all RHSOC members.
- FY18: \$5,665.60 left after completing all purchases. IST had returned all their money so this left us with a surplus. This extra money will be sent back
- FY19: Over half of the funds have been spent. Requisition for a bomb suit will be completed
- FY20: Risk assessment has been done completed for everyone. Waiting on cybersecurity to be completed before sub-agreements can be issued and money can be spent.
- 2. Inventory Disposition Requests

Only one request at this time: New radios were acquired for Greene County Communications
vehicles, so the old radios were traded in. Waiting on RHSOC approval so the radios can be
removed from the inventory. EMS motioned to accept the disposition, Fire seconded the motion.
Motion passed unanimously with no further discussion.

New Business

1. Region D RHSOC By-laws Addition

 Formal action is required to add an amendment to the RHSOC by-laws to include Cybersecurity, which brings us up to 18 disciplines. Motioned from Utilities and seconded by Fire. Motion passed unanimously with further discussion.

 further discussion.
